SIZE

Before you decide which shed to buy, you should make sure that you are choosing a size that will be sufficient for it's purpose. We actually recommend choosing a shed that is one size larger than what you think you will need just to be sure. If you are storing large items, such as a tractor, ATV, lawnmowers, etc., you may need to also take into consideration the door width and building height as well as length and width that you will need.

If you're still unsure if you've chosen the correct size, it may help to create a visual using garden stakes and string. Measure and section off the exact size of the building that you plan to purchase so you can see how much space you will actually have as well as how the building will fit in your yard. You could even arrange your larger items in the space to help you visualize how it will all fit.

Also, don't forget about the potential for future growth. As time goes by, you'll accumulate more things and require additional storage space. Choosing a larger shed now could save you from having to buy more buildings later.





ACCESSIBILITY

It's important to make sure that your shed is easily accessible for its purpose.

For example, if you are using your new shed as extra storage for gardening tools, it would be inconvenient to place it too far away from your garden. Or if you plan to use it to store extra toys for your kids, you may want to place it near an area that they often use when playing outdoors. If your building is in an easily accessible location, you will be less tempted to leave items out of place and create clutter.

Also, if you think you will ever decide to run water or electricity to your building, you will want to make sure it's placed in a location where that can be set up easily.
