TIPS FOR ORGANIZING YOUR STORAGE SPACE

Make Use of Vertical Space for Small and Medium Sized Items

Use shelves, hooks, tool hangers, etc. to make use of vertical space, freeing up as much floor space as possible.

Floor Space is a Virtue

The floor of a shed is usually the first area to be filled. Save this space for large items, such as lawnmowers, ATVs, motorcycles, and pressure washers. Don't forget to leave open walkways for yourself! You need to be able to get around in your building.

Get Rid of Things You Don't Need

Give away items that you rarely or never use. Your space is valuable, so don't let it become cluttered with items that you know you probably won't use.

Group Similar Items

Group similar items together and label the containers in which they're stored. There's no use in having items if you can't find them when you need them.

Trace Your Tools

When everything has a place to go, pieces are seldom lost. Keep track of smaller tools and easily misplaced items by hanging them on a designated "tool wall" using hooks or nails. To prevent yourself from forgetting any missing items, trace the shape of the tools onto the wall with a permanent marker.
